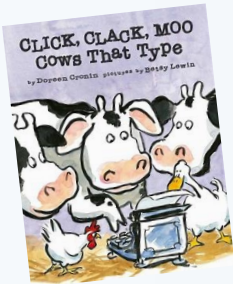
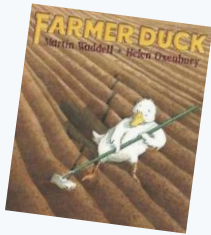
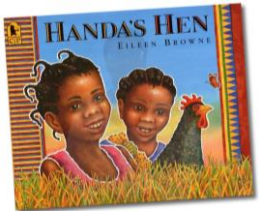


Communication & Language

This half term in oracy we will be teaching children to face the person they are speaking to. Spell words by identifying the sound and then writing the sound with letters. Children will demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words. Our Talk Through Stories texts which we will use to teach new vocabulary are:



Literacy

We will continue to develop skills through 'Drawing Club' texts. We will be focusing capital letters, spelling red words, finger spaces and using full stops when writing sentences. We will write words in letter family groups in handwriting sessions to practice correct letter formation

Phonics

Children will continue to learn in their phonics groups. Some groups will be starting on their set 3 sounds and others will be continuing with recapping and consolidating their set 1 and 2 sounds. Please support your child at home by watching the weekly RWI virtual classroom videos.

Maths

In our maths lessons we will be learning the following objectives through hands on practical activities:

- Investigating more and less
- Organising numbers
- Recognising 5 'and a bit'
- Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system
- Have a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number
- Explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including evens and odds, double facts and how quantities can be distributed equally

Key questions & stem sentences:

Looking at different groups of objects, ask your child: "Which group has the most? Which has the fewest?" or "Is it an equal amount?"

When looking at groups of objects, ask: "How can you make that number, Can you show me another way?"
