English

This half term, we will be writing a diary entry on an adventure in the Ancient Egyptian pyramids. The children will look closely at using subordinating conjunctions and prepositions to improve their sentence structure.

We will then look at fact writing based on the Tutankhamun. The children will carry out their own research and then organise their ideas into groups. They will look at effective fact files and the importance of the design.

Master Reading

We will be reading Coming to England by Floella Benjamin. We will learn how to accurately answer comprehension questions including inference questions (using clues in the text to justify our answers) and we will explain the meaning of new vocabulary so we can confidently use it ourselves.

Please continue to read the Accelerated Reader books and do the quizzes. We will monitor this weekly. Library day is Monday.

French

This term the children will be moving on from numbers, colours and shape in French and be looking at French in the classroom. The children will learn names for common school items in French and follow instructions in French. They will also look at asking and answering questions in French.

Maths:

Capacity



We will finish off our measurement unit and will focus on liquids and capacity. We will convert between litres and millilitres and read scales counting in 100s, 200s, 250s and 500s, where the numbers are not marked.

Fractions

The children will begin another unit of work on fractions. The children will consolidate their learning of numerators and denominators as well as recapping fractions on a number line.

We will add and subtract fractions, find fractions of a set of objects and begin to solve complex problems concerning fractions

Money

We will convert between pounds and pence, we will add and subtract money using the column method. We will know they 100p makes £1 and find change.
