

Communication & Language:

- To use my listening ears when sitting in small group times for short periods of time.
- To join in singing familiar nursery rhymes
- To follow a simple instruction
- To recognise and match different sounds (early phonics)

Literacy:

- To share my books with an adult holding it up the right way and turning the pages
- To listen to a short story and talk about it
- To hold a pencil and make marks on paper

Expressive Arts & Design:

- To learn new songs including 'I've got a Body and Head Shoulders Knees & Toes'
- To select and use craft resources independently
- To paint/draw/collage a self portrait

Understanding the World:

- To talk about our families and people that live with us in our homes
- To recognise how we are all unique



Autumn 1 - Nursery It's Good To Be Me!



During this topic we will talk about families and what makes us unique. We will use mirrors to look at ourselves and talk about what we see.

We will read lots of stories including our key texts 'Hair Love', 'Where's My Teddy and The Train Ride'. We will also talk about the meaning of Harvest.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To practice turn taking
- To understand routines such as using the toilet and handwashing in nursery
- To become familiar with staff in nursery and ask for help when needed

Maths:

- To sort objects according to size and colour
- To practice counting aloud for different purposes
- To show number fingers to 3

Physical Development:

- To use a jug to pour own milk or water at snack time
- To thread beads/pegs
- To climb and balance on the grass blocks independently
