Once Upon a Time...



Our topic for the first half of the spring term is 'Once Upon a Time'. We will focus on one key text every week Goldilocks and The Three Bears, The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs, The Little Red Hen and The Three Billy Goats Gruff. For our final week we will celebrate the stories and dress up as one of our favourite characters from the stories!

Expressive Arts & Design:

Exploring different materials to develop own ideas about how to use them and what to make.

Learn new songs related to our traditional tales.

Use blocks and construction kits to construct with a purpose – house for the 3 Little Pigs.

Maths:

Subitise up to 3 objects.

Say number name for each item in order.

Count a set and know last number is total.

Show finger numbers up to 5.

Talk about 2D and 3D shapes.

Describe familiar routes.

Physical Development:

Fine Motor – tweezers, threading, using pincer grip, mark making, dough, using scissors

Gross Motor – PE with apparatus (climbing/jumping/balancing), dance with scarves & ribbons.
