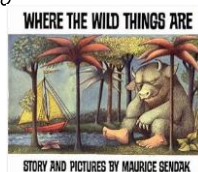


English

We have started to learn cursive handwriting. This is where we join the letters together. This term, we will continue to focus on making the letters the same size, joining them together whilst remembering not to join capital letters.

- To count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals

- To recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- To recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity

- To develop agility and co-ordination.
- To explore hopping, jumping and leaping for distance.
- To develop throwing for distance and accuracy
